



Daily Cleaning Routines

Wellness is an ongoing goal among our staff & families. We want to take the opportunity to share about our cleaning routines and illness prevention.

Products

Our purchased cleaners are professional grade disinfectant products, purchased by our facility for the staff, and the contracted cleaning service to use.

Classroom Cleaning Routines

Daily classroom day cleaning occurs in the classroom by Grace UMC Preschool staff. Table tops and surfaces are cleaned throughout the day, especially before and after mealtimes.

Toys in classrooms are washed as needed during the day of use, and are also sprayed with a disinfectant misting at the close of each day.

Changing tables are cleaned after each use. A paper-liner is placed on the changing table pad prior to a child being changed. The teacher has gloves, wipes and the child's diaper ready as diaper changing begins. After disposing of all soiled items, the child washes their hands. The teacher sanitizes the changing table, and the teacher washes hands.

After Hours Cleaning

A professional cleaning group is contracted to clean each evening after preschool and church programming. This group follows up on the larger cleaning tasks of mopping, vacuuming, and the disinfection of bathrooms and sinks.

Oversight

In addition to management at Grace UMC, The Health Department and Department of Human Services monitors the cleaning practices of our facility.

Handwashing

Wellness is an on-going goal. We ask the children and staff to follow good hand-washing habits: Before and after meals, Before and after bathrooming, Before & after using tissue, and after being outside.
